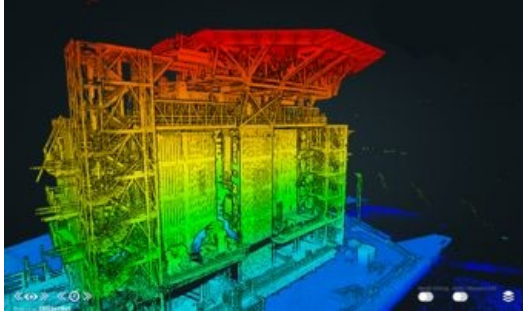


3DUserNet to Power TexoDrone Online 3D Data Platform
